AEROSPACE ED CORNER

Space Shuttle Atlantis went into orbit Thurs
with Europe's gift to the international space
station, a \$2 billion science lab named Colum-
bus that spent years waiting to set sail. Prob-
ably no one was happier than the 300 Europe-
ans who gathered at the launch site to see At-
lantis take off with their beloved Columbus lab.
They celebrated with Belgian & French choco-
lates and sparkling grape juice, in keeping with
NASA's no-alcohol rule at the Kennedy Space
Center. Twenty three years in the making,
Columbus is the European Space Agency's pri-
mary contribution to the space station. The lab
has endured redesigns and slowdowns, as well
as a number of shuttle postponements and two
shuttle accidents. Columbus will join the U.S.
lab, Destiny, which was launched aboard At-
lantis exactly seven years ago. The much big-
ger Japanese lab Kibo, or Hope, will require
three shuttle flights to get off the ground, be-
ginning in March.
