CIVIL AIR PATROL POLICY OF NONDISCRIMINATION:

IAW CAPR 36-2, para 2. dated 15 May 2006, it is Civil Air Patrol policy that no member shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or subjected to discrimination in any CAP program or activity on the basis of race, sex, age, color, religion, national origin or disability (formerly handicap). It is Civil Air Patrol policy that no applicant meeting CAP's minimum age requirement will be denied membership in CAP on the basis of race, sex, age, color, religion, national origin, or disability (formerly handicap). IAW CAPR 36-2, para 4 c (2), All Wing Commanders will ensure that the CAP Nondiscrimination Policy is briefed annually to all members within their respective commands.
