AEROSPACE ED CORNER

According to NASA, "The recent flurry of tropical cyclones in the Atlantic is a reminder that we are now entering the climatological peak of the Atlantic hurricane season. The 2008 season is turning out to be well above average so far. Following close on the heels of Hurricane Gustav, which hit the southern Louisiana coast as a category 2 storm on the morning of Sept. 1, are Hanna, Ike and Josephine, the eight, ninth & tenth names storms of the season. On average, there are 10 named storms for the entire season, which officially runs through the end of November. Ike became a category 4 storm on the evening of Sept. 3rd, making it the third major and fifth overall hurricane of the season. Typically there are 6 hurricanes in the Atlantic in any given year with 2 or 3 becoming major. Currently, Hanna, Ike and Josephine all remain alive in the Atlantic.
