COMMANDER'S CALL

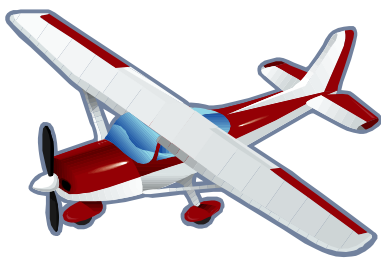

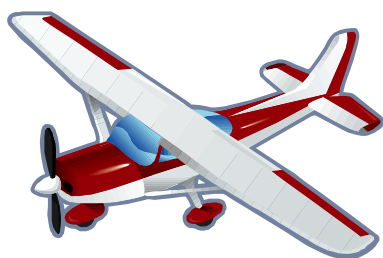

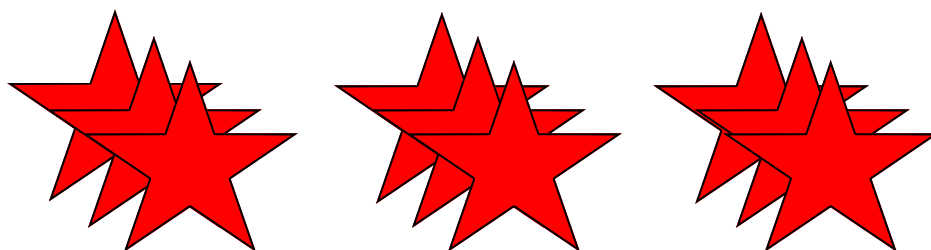
