He was a member of the Civil Air Patrol and Commander of the former Custer Composite Squadron. He served with the U.S. Air Force in World War II, flying more than 90 flights. 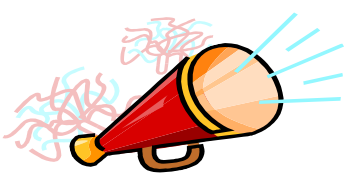
LOOKING FOR SOME YEAGERS!
