When you renew your state driver's license, be sure to renew your CAP driver's license also. A NEWG Form 332, a copy of your state driver's license and the State driving motor vehicle record must be sent to Wing Headquarters. Go to [www.dmv.state.ne.us](http://www.dmv.state.ne.us) and click on the link to download an application. There is a fee of \$3.00 which must accompany your application. This can be done by mail or taken to your local Dept. of Motor Vehicle Office. Some insurance companies may print off your record for you.

Civil Air Patrol's Aerospace Education offers a very popular program free to its members that involves doing hands-on aviation and space-related activities with students. It is called AEX, and the acronym stands for "Aerospace Education EXcellence". Teachers receive full-color books that feature national standards-based aerospace activities. Once you receive the AEX books, all you have to do is complete six activities (either in the books or mail an aerospace education lesson plan of your choice) during the school year and complete at least a two hour field experience (such as a space day, aerospace-related field trip, rocket launch, etc.) to earn a beautiful 11 x 14 wooden plaque plus color certificates for your students. The activities are designed to fit into any curriculum.
